After reviewing plans for the construction of the playground a better solution was determined that would benefit both this project and the planned rehabilitation to the tennis courts. This modification will correct the drainage problem that causes regular flooding of the tennis courts and will provide additional seating around the playground. The solution includes the a raised concrete curb that will direct water flows away from the playground and tennis courts. The raised curb will step down into the play area creating a stadium style seating area.

The additional seating and drainage improvements will provide a place to rest and supervise children using the playground as well as reduce maintenance and cleaning of the tennis courts.


