The permanent fencing proposed will replace the existing temporary construction fence that is currently being used at the Town Ice Rink. The fencing project is urgent as it the current fence is owned by a contractor that needs the fence for another project, this leaves to Town no option but to buy or rent a fence. The typical cost to rent a construction fence cost is \$3753 every 4 months or nearly \$15,000 a year. The cost to purchase a permanent fence is \$21,000. It is more cost effective for the Town to purchase a fence.
