Purpose of organization: Baseball instruction – "Teaching life lessons through baseball to kids ages 4-15."

FUNDING INFORMATION

Amount of funding request: \$ 3,700

Please describe how the funds received in 2013 were spent:

In 2013, we spent our TOML Youth Sports Funding Grant (\$3700) on uniforms. Uniform costs totaled \$6,277.87 last season (including All Star Uniforms.) All players are given hats, pants and socks to keep. Additionally they are loaned jerseys and belts, which they return to MCLL at the end of the season.

Please describe how the requested funding for 2014 will be used:

If granted, funds for 2014 will be used again to purchase uniforms. This allows us to keep our registration fees as low as possible. Again this year we will purchase socks, pants and hats for each player; we are also budgeting to replace worn jerseys and belts this year.

What other sources have you pursued to obtain funding? (e.g., fundraising events, grants, increased participant fees?) Please attach any information that will assist in establishing the funding history of the organization.

Annual funding comes from Registration Fees, Sponsorships, and Community Grants. Families pay \$70 per child, with possible discounts for "earlybird" registration, multiple children, and coaches. Local businesses support our program via sponsorships with levels ranging from \$25-\$500. We request grants from both Mono County (\$3,000 approved for 2014) and from the Town of Mammoth Lakes. New for 2014 we are working with the Women's Club to help staff the snack shack, both to help their program and to raise additional funds for MCLL.

If yes, indicate the nature of the usage, the estimated number of participant hours, and any expenses incurred by your organization for the prep and maintenance of the facility used by your organization.

We use Shady Rest ballfields and Whitmore ballfields. Our season runs from late March through early July, including pre-season practice, regular season and post-season play. During that time, we estimate 10,540 youth participation hours total, which includes 5,440 hours of practice time (170kids x 32 hours) and 5100 hours of game time (170 kids x 30 hours). All of our coaches are volunteers so there is no expense when they do field work.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

Duration of the program's season (days per year): Our program lasts approximately 12 weeks, or 84 days. This includes practices, games (regular season games are played in a 6 week period) and post-season play.

Number of youth participating: We estimate approximately 170—175 kids will participate in 2014. We are still receiving late registration requests.

Percentage of Mammoth Lakes area **full-time** residents (including Crowley and other nearby areas): All of our participants are full-time residents of Mono County, as per Little League National regulations. Of those, in 2014 approximately 83% live in Mammoth Lakes and Crowley.

Number of **adult volunteer hours** involved with the program (specific program set up, maintenance, etc. – provide details):

We are an organization run entirely by volunteers. Our board consists of 14 volunteers, and for 2014 we estimate that we will we have a total of approximately 80 adult volunteers register. We estimate that well over 3,000 volunteer hours go into our program, including approximately 2,790 hours of coaching time, 200 hours of board meeting time, 200 hours of event/program preparation, and 150 hours of miscellaneous tasks.

What type of measures or procedures do you take to promote good sportsmanship among the players, coaches and parents? Are there policies in place to discourage abusive behavior and language towards participants, coaches and officials?

Good sportsmanship is at the core of our Little League Fundamentals.

- Our player and parent pledges include verbiage of fair play, doing our best, and respecting others (including other players, coaches and umpires.) Both pledges are distributed and recited at Opening Day.
- All coaches are required to attend "Positive Coaching Alliance" training.
- Each year we award Player of The Year to the player that embraces good sportsmanship, respect for the game and for others and shows leadership within their team.
- Often these efforts will prevent any abusive behavior/language, but if not, abusive players/coaches are subject to game suspensions.

Outside of your program, what type of community programs or projects does your organization participate in?

New for 2014, we are working with the Mammoth Lakes Women's Club to assist with staffing the snack shack for all seasons including Little League, Adult Softball and AYSO. We do this both to support their organization and to raise additional funds for our organization.

In addition, our board members actively volunteer (and hold board/leadership positions in many cases) with other local organizations including: AYSO, Mammoth Sharks Swim Team, Girl Scouts of the Eastern Sierra, Mammoth Lakes Foundation, Mammoth Lakes Repertory Theater, Mono Council for the Arts, Mammoth Mountain Community Foundation, Friends of the Library, Disabled Sports Eastern Sierra, Mammoth Elementary School PTO, Mammoth Middle School Organization, Mammoth Schools NOW Education Foundation, Mammoth Schools classroom volunteer, Bridgeport Schools volunteer, Bridgeport Regional Planning Advisory Committee, Bridgeport Public Utilities District, Bridgeport Founders Day, and more.

We are grateful for past support from the Town of Mammoth Lakes. It is critical that we keep registration fees at a manageable level – otherwise we are not able to field enough players and teams to have a strong program in our small community. All local children are encouraged to play Little League baseball. Our registration flyers and forms are printed in both English and Spanish.

Almost 2/3 of our participants receive a discounted registration rate - including early bird discounts, family multi-player discounts, volunteer discounts and full or partial scholarships. We strive to keep our program costs down and to be affordable to most families, yet do offer scholarships so that no child is denied the ability to play if they cannot afford the fee.

While we encourage players to purchase their own equipment, we do not require it, like many other Little League regions. We supply bats, helmets and catchers gear for each team.

We are entirely run with volunteers – from board members to coaches to umpires. We strive to provide a solid program teaching baseball fundamentals and life skills through baseball. Thank you for considering our request.
