EQUIPMENT USE CONDITIONS

1. This equipment was purchased by Measure R Funds. Please be respectful of the equipment and notify staff of damage or needed repairs. Excessive use may result in the forfeiture of the deposit. Use of this equipment is First come – first serve, pending the submittal of a complete application form and deposit.
2. This equipment use agreement shall begin on the date specified, and expire on the specified date in the application. At the end of this time period, if the applicant wishes to keep the equipment for additional time, the event producer needs to contact the Parks and Recreation Department for approval prior to such activity.
3. All used equipment and town signs/equipment must be returned to the Town within 3-days after the event in the same condition (including filling up the gas tanks in the generators) in which it was lent. Your organization is responsible for any damage to the equipment. Town representatives will inspect the equipment upon return for functionality and cleanliness and advise the user of any anticipated or potential fees.
4. In the event that problems arise due to the conduct of this activity, the Parks and Recreation Department Director/Manager reserves the right to review this permit and attach additional conditions as deemed appropriate or to revoke all privileges granted by this permit.
5. It shall be the applicant's responsibility to know and comply with all County, State, Federal, and local laws.
6. In consideration of the acceptance of the rented equipment, the signatory/applicant hereby indemnifies, holds harmless, waives, releases, and discharges in advance, and shall require and cause all participants and volunteers using the rental equipment to so indemnify, hold harmless, waive, release, and discharge in advance, the Town of Mammoth Lakes, including its officers, agents, servants, volunteers and employees, from any and all claims, causes of action, damages, penalties and liability, including, but not limited to, those arising out of death, bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage occurring as a result of said activity, notwithstanding any negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entity named above and even if such persons and entity would otherwise be liable.
7. It is understood that the activity mentioned above and on all attachments involves an element of risk associated with the activity, whether known or unknown, and whether known or unknown to the persons and entity above named.
